The key trait of all Creature Crafts is that they can be rolled back to an upright position while remaining seated in the boat. This is achieved with the aid of the patented roll cage design which limits the boat from settling upside down. The roll cage also helps protect the crew from rocks and other objects when the boat is on its side; though you must always be aware of your surroundings.

The structural integrity of the Creature Crafts multiple chambers remains firm in its form, and does not crush or wrap. The patented lap belt system also greatly reduces the risk of a swim and the self-righting abilities of the boat completely change the consequences of a flip. The paddle team or oars person can easily roll the craft right side up and continue on their journey. Paddling or rowing a Creature Craft provides the ability to achieve whitewater pinnacles that were thought to be un-runable. In some instances, the Creature Craft is the only way you can even consider putting on the water.

WHITEWATER MODELS

If you're just getting started or are an experienced river runner, the Creature Craft introduces a whole new style of running rivers. Big continuous whitewater abundant with hydraulics, steep drops, and gigantic waves become incredible playgrounds. The general idea remains the same, Go out, have fun, stay safe, and learn by challenging yourself in the process.

Generation 2 series: The 10'6" Yacamana is the most nimble and drivable. Can be used as an oar rig and R2. It is an amazing boat but also the most difficult to re-right. This is the pros boat. The 11'6" Makara is a very nimble and agile boat, capable of running the biggest hydraulics, the tightest creeks and the most technical rivers. Great single oar rig.

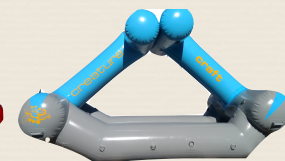

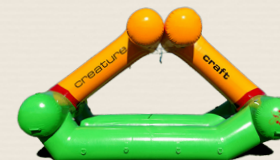
Generation 4 series: The 10'8" Nargun is the best self-righter of all the smaller Creature Crafts. It is great as an R2 and single oar rig. The 12'8" Agua Mala is a transition boat between the big and little boats. It is nimble like the little boats, but able to deal with the bigger hydraulics. It is a phenomenal single oar rig while it functions well as an R2, is big enough for R4, and can carry a passenger seat. The 14'3" Bacoon handles easily as a single oar rig and makes a great expedition boat. It is also big enough to be a dual oar rig, carry gear and have a passenger seat. The 16'2" Charybdis is extremely stable and our biggest Creature Craft. It can be used as a single/dual oar rig, R4, R5, with center mount oar rig and 4 paddlers being the best for commercial use configuration.
